As well as fabrics made of CO, CO/PA, CO/PES, PES, AR and in blends with CV, PA and EL, MAC in blends with CO, CV, CLY, PA, PES, PAN, AR, EL and Elastolefin also in blends with antistatic fibres, with or without coating or laminate and partly produced with fibres having flame retardant properties or finished with flame retardant products accepted by OEKO-TEX®. Rainwear made of knitted backing of PES or PA with PU coating. Knitted underwear made of PES/EL, WO and in blends with PA, PP and EL as well as WO/MAC/antistatic fibres produced with fibres accepted by OEKO-TEX® having flame retardant properties. Socks made of WO/PA/EL, CO/PA/EL, PA/PP/EL, PES/PA/EL, WO/PAN/PA/EL, PA/PES/PP/EL and MAC/CO/PA/EL also in blends with antistatic ... [Please scan QR code for full scope]
